New Members Inducted Into Hall of Fame

Three hundred alumni, faculty, family and friends gathered on Sunday, April 29 at the Liberty House Restaurant for the induction of the second class of members into the Hudson Catholic Hall of Fame. The class represents over 140 years of service to Hudson Catholic and its students.

Catherine Greene was presented by Assistant Principal, Mrs. Joan Serafin; Walter Plunkett by former Principal, Brother Luke Maher, FSC; Phil Gazzale by President / Principal, Dr. Paul Ward and Thomas F. X. Bender by Thomas R. Clark, '76. Brian J. Neary, Esq., '69 presided as the Master of Ceremonies.

New Principal Named at Hudson Catholic High School

Dr. Paul Ward, president of Hudson Catholic Regional High School, announced the appointment of *Brother James Dries, F.S.C.* The appointment was effective July 1, 2007.

Brother James's appointment was made in consultation with the Archdiocese of Newark and the De La Salle Christian Brothers of the Baltimore District, who have staffed the school since its founding in 1964.

Dr. Ward will continue to serve as full-time president of Hudson Catholic, one of the Archdiocese of Newark's seven regional high schools. Brother James has served at CBA, Lincroft since 2004, overseeing student discipline and behavior, coordinating student activities, and implementing all school policies that effect student life.

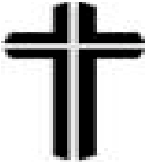
Before joining the staff of Christian Brothers Academy, Brother James served as principal of Mwangaza Centre, a mission of the Christian Brothers in Kenya, East Africa, and as headmaster of a Brothers school in St. Vincent, British West Indies. Brother James has served in teaching and administrative posts for the Brothers in the United States, including Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and New York.

"The appointment of Brother James as principal will allow Hudson Catholic to strengthen the president and principal model," said Dr. Ward, who sees the appointment as coming at a critical time in the history of the school.

"My appointment as president-principal in 2005 was the first step in creating a new administrative model for the school designed to identify new sources of support for the school." The appointment of Brother James is the final step in that plan.

"Brother James' appointment will place the day-to-day operation of the school in his hands and allow me to concentrate on strengthening Hudson Catholic by reaching out to people beyond the immediate school community who share our commitment to the Catholic and Lasallian formation of young men for college, service-oriented citizenship and eternal life.

"Most Catholic high schools that use the president and principal model have two different people in those roles. With the appointment of Brother James as principal, Hudson Catholic now joins the ranks of these schools as we move confidently into the future," Dr. Ward said. *(continued on last page)*

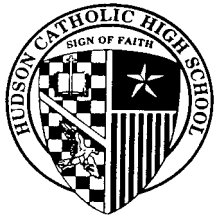
